

KBEA Scholarship Application Guidelines & Form

The Kansas Business Education Association (KBEA) Scholarship will be awarded annually at the KBEA Convention, generally held in the fall. The scholarship will be in the amount as specified by the Executive Board, as well as the number of scholarships awarded. (2019 is approved for one \$250 scholarship.)

The scholarship can be awarded for *undergraduate* work in business education or *graduate* work in a business related field. Applications for the scholarship will be submitted to the KBEA Past-President by **September 1, 2021**. Applicants must submit a transcript indicating they are a qualified junior or senior undergraduate business education student or a graduate student at an accredited college or university and complete the application process.

Applicants must have a minimum overall grade point average of **3.0 on a 4.0 scale** in their post-secondary work. The scholarship will only be awarded once to an applicant. Applicants **must** be members or student members of KBEA.
